



Award for fantastic plastic

AN innovative company has won a national environmental award for a product which uses recycled plastic.

Cosset Industries won the Infrastructure Australia Green Award for its PlastiPole bin holders.

The PlastiPole is made entirely from recycled plastic and has a range of features that make it attractive to councils.

Used to secure mobile garbage bins in public spaces, the pole is designed with a fast-release system for easy emptying, does not rust and has a secure locking mechanism that reduces the risk of vandalism and theft.

Director Andrew Townsend said the product was a success.

“And every council that has been offered a trial has taken it up,” he said.

“The attraction of the PlastiPole is that it offers a low-cost replacement for the rusting and often unsafe metal bin holders that are widely used.”

Cosset makes all its street and park accessories from either 100 per cent recycled plastic or a new recycled product called EverTuff.

Mr Townsend said the award validated the company’s investment: “This award confirms our belief the product delivers outstanding value while also providing an environmental benefit.”
